STEP 1 ➤

Visit Schools

The **FIRST AIM** of Lions Quest is for ALL SCHOOLS TO BE AWARE of these excellent programs. When schools are planning their programming for social and emotional learning and student wellbeing, we want them to know that Lions Quest is an option well worth considering.

School programming priorities vary from school to school and change with time, so we want every school to know about LIONS QUEST.

*We want them to know that **Skills for Growing** and **Skills for Adolescence** are evidence-based programs with a history of success and we want to be their program of choice for their *SEL implementation.*

SO, WHAT CAN **YOU** DO ABOUT THIS?



MAKE SURE YOUR LOCAL SCHOOLS KNOW ABOUT THE LIONS QUEST PROGRAMS!

1. Identify your local primary and secondary schools and deliver a Lions Quest information pack to each of them.
2. Request a meeting with the Wellbeing Coordinator, Counsellor, Head of Curriculum, Head of Health and Phys Ed ... or another appropriate person.
3. Take a CURRICULUM PACK to the meeting and offer to leave it with them for a few days so teachers can have a look.
4. Let them know you'll call back in a week or so to see what they think and/or collect the curriculum pack.

Revisit Schools
